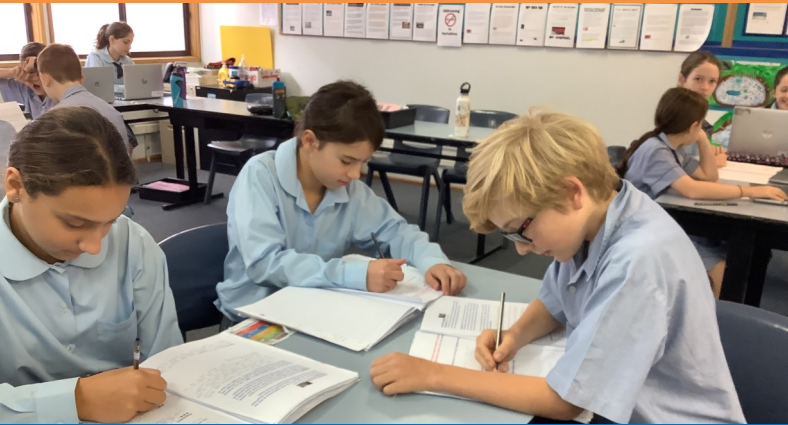


# Year 5M Class Page

Joshua, Sidney and Lucia brainstorming collaboratively possible arguments, prior to writing their plan.

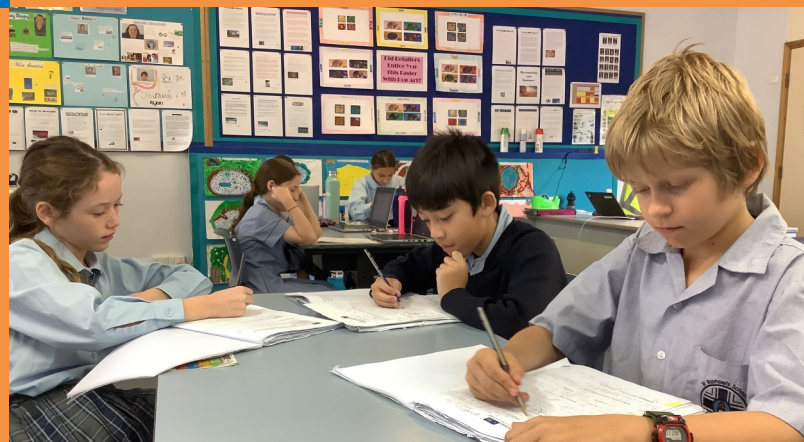


Mia, Natalia & Max planning their exposition.
