Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the priests in our parish will not give any homilies, rather we will hear directly from our Archbishop – via a Video presentation in what would normally be the homily time.

Archbishop Patrick O'Regan will be speaking to all of us about the coming 'Archdiocesan Assembly'. The 2021 Adelaide Diocesan Assembly will be held on 17 & 18 September at Cabra Dominican College and is a gathering of representatives from the various communities and agencies of the Archdiocese of Adelaide to discuss the life of the church and make recommendations.

The primary aims of this Assembly are (i) to prepare our diocese for the upcoming Plenary Council and (ii) to begin a process of working towards a Vison for our Archdiocese.

I might add too, that Archbishop O'Regan hopes to form a Diocesan Pastoral Council and the Assembly may also help this process by offering advice about this goal.

So, the Diocesan Assembly is a separate and stand-alone event, but it will help us to prepare for the Plenary Council of Australia and help to inform our delegates so that they can best represent the views of our community in South Australia.

While South Australia, will only have a small number of 'delegates' at the Plenary Council, by contrast the Diocesan Assembly event will involve representatives from every Parish and School. Thus, we will have significant representation from Glen Osmond/Parkside.

This weekend we will also have 'postcards' available for you so that everyone can offer ideas and suggestions about the key issues we should consider in the Diocesan Assembly. These postcards are pre-paid and may be mailed back to the Archdiocesan Offices. You may wish to take one home to other members of your family or friends to give them a voice also. Alternatively, there is a QR code that enables you or others to submit ideas 'online'.

It is important for us to appreciate that the document that will inform the coming Plenary Council of Australia namely, The Light from the Southern Cross, speaks of the Church as 'Synodal'. That is, as a Church which involves the active participation of all members in processes of discernment, consultation, and co-operation at every level of decision making and mission. Let us rise to this challenge.
